

January 2020 Panellist Remuneration Rates

In accordance with NWPTA Schedule 5, Panellist Remuneration, there is an annual inflationary increase linked to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) rate from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

(Remuneration increased linked to 2019 CPI rate: 1.9% (Statistics Canada))

Panellist Remuneration

Paragraph 3: Individuals sitting as panellists are entitled to charge up to a maximum of \$127.38 per hour, to a maximum of \$1019.04 per day for all work, not including travel time, required to be undertaken by them while carrying out their duties as panellists, commencing as of the time they are officially appointed to a dispute settlement panel constituted under Part IV.

Paragraph 4: Individuals sitting as panellists are entitled to charge up to a maximum of \$63.69 per hour, to a maximum of \$509.52 per day, for any travel that is required to be undertaken by them as part of their duties as panellists, commencing as of the time they are officially appointed to a dispute settlement panel constituted under Part IV.
